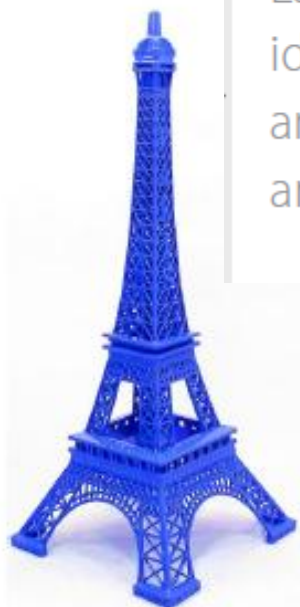

REGIONAL NETWORK FOR MARINE PROJECTS

The GEF LME:LEARN supports Regional Networks to improve regional governance and cooperation within and among respective LME regions by facilitating collaboration between LME, MPA, MSP, ICM, fisheries, biodiversity and climate change projects funded by the GEF and other sources of financing. To date, LME:LEARN's direct involvement has actively supported projects in three regional networks: Africa, Latin America and the Caribbean, and Asia. Regional Networks work on the prioritization of training needs; identification and prioritization of the twinning opportunities; identification of scientific research needs and Inter-project Collaboration Opportunities (ICO). Regional Networks convene at least once a year and are supplemented by regular virtual communication.

What is the GEF LME:LEARN Project?

A key element of improved ocean governance is mainstreaming cooperation and coordination between Large Marine Ecosystems, Marine Protected Areas (MPAs), Integrated Coastal Management (ICM) and Marine Spatial Planning (MSP) projects with overlapping themes and geographic areas, both for GEF projects and for non-GEF projects.

GEF LME:LEARN aims to reach a variety of marine and coastal stakeholders including project managers, international and local project staff, government officials, implementing agency staff, non-governmental organizations, business community and others.

How many Regional Networks is the GEF LME:LEARN project establishing?

Three regions have been selected :

- Africa
- Latin America - and the Caribbean
- Asia and the Pacific

How will the Regional Networks Interact?

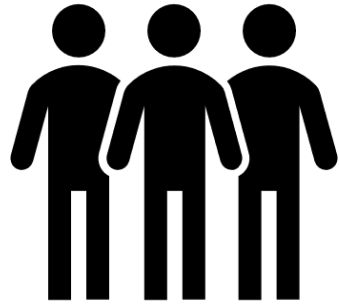

INTER-PROJECT COLLABORATION OPPORTUNITIES (ICO)

Inter-project Collaboration Opportunities (ICO) are seed funding grants for GEF marine and coastal projects to collaborate with each other, non-GEF projects and/or Regional Bodies that are active in the LME:LEARN Regional Networks. The funding allows them to team up and address common/transboundary issues, maximize resources and human capacity, and/or facilitate networking. The grant funds will cover necessary air tickets and DSA (per diem) allowances to facilitate the execution of the ICO grant.
