A. Coordination w/other projects

- Refine parameters to earmark other GEF IW projects' funds for IW:LEARN involvement
- Identify any other inputs needed from IW:LEARN into IWTF meeting on June 6

B. Budget Revisions and Expenditures

- Review UNEP-IW:LEARN budget/expense report (through 2005) for Component A (info. sharing), Activities B1.1 (Caribbean Multi-Focal) and D1 (Southeast Asia Regional Learning Center) and approve budget revision, if requested.
- Identify options for re-allocation of un-used Activity B3 and D3 funds. B3 (Inter-Project Exchange) has \$40k unspent from year 1, tentatively moved to years 2-3, while D3 (IWRM, Roundtables) as ~\$57k remaining for IAs IW Experience Notes and \$65k set aside funds to address emerging needs of both IWTF and projects. Options, e.g.:

Option 0: Default - leave funds as is for later use.

Option 1: Redirect \$20-30/year (for 2 years) for demand-driven collaboration with projects and remainder for GEF IWTF corporate-driven activities.
