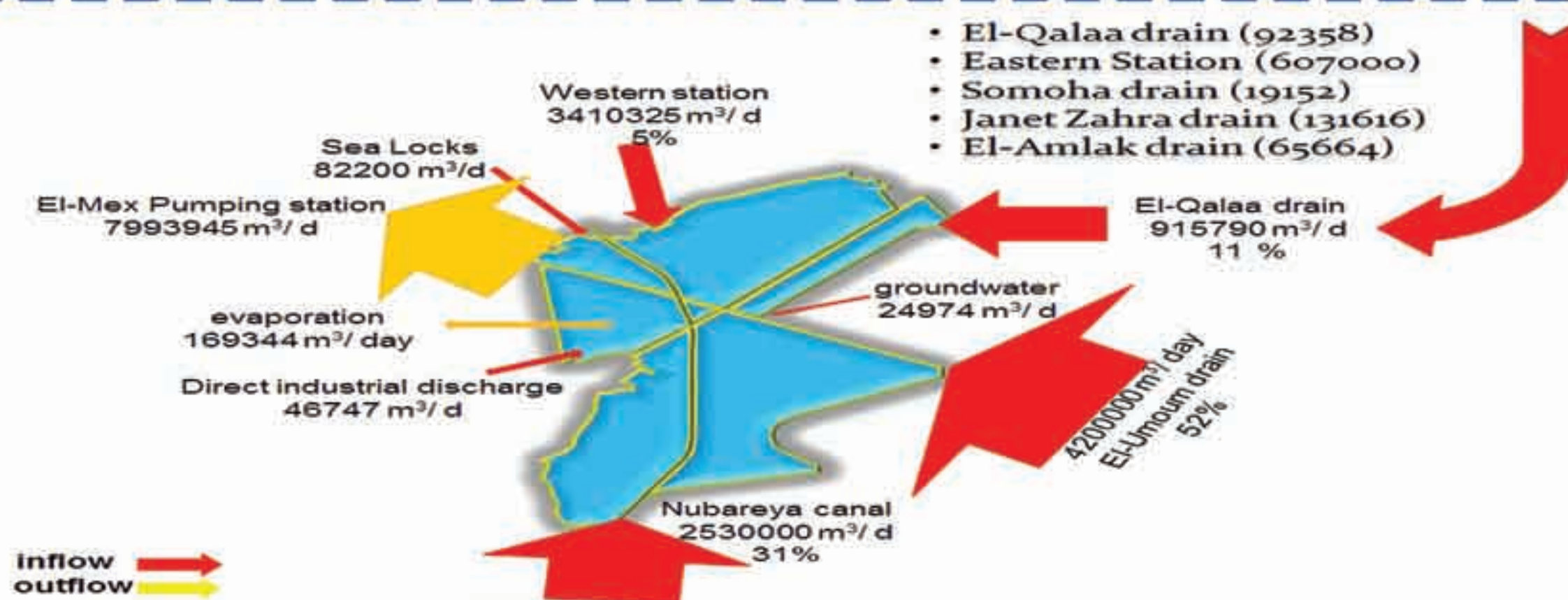
Who We Are

The Alexandria Coastal Zone Management project (2010-2015) is financed by a Global Environment Facility (GEF) grant of US\$ 7.15 million managed through the World Bank. The Egyptian Environmental Affairs Agency (EEAA) is the agency responsible for overall implementation.

Our Target

- Adopting the ICZM plan and implementing the institutional mechanism successfully;
- Achieving 5% reduction in the pollution loads entering the Mediterranean Sea through Lake Mariout by applying low cost technology for pollution reduction that can be scaled-up and replicated together with the upgrade of the East Waste Water Treatment Plant and reed removal from the lake.

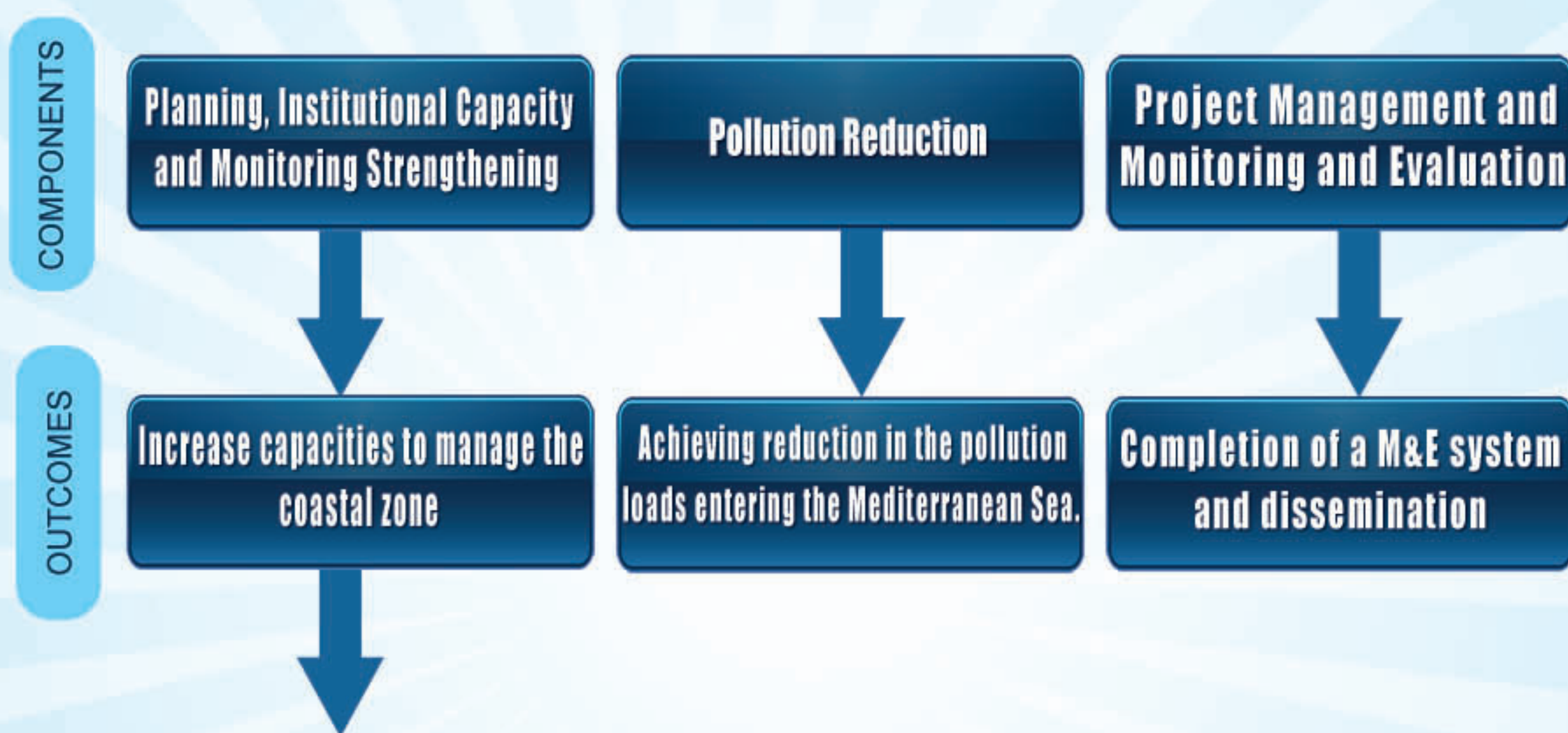
