Call for Contributions

Key dates for contributions

The process by which contributions to the Forum are submitted, selected and accepted is:

1 June 2007
You are able to submit your proposal(s) electronically to this website.

31 July 2007
You must submit your concept proposal(s) before this deadline if you want to be considered in the **first round** of offers. Details of how to submit your proposal are explained on the following pages.

31 August 2007
The proposals submitted for the first round will be reviewed against criteria. By the end of August you will be notified if your proposal has been accepted, declined or held until the second round of selection. The majority of the events will be selected in this round.

30 September 2007
Your proposal(s) must be submit before this deadline if you want to be considered in the **second round**.

31 October 2007
Proposals submitted for the second round will be reviewed against a set of criteria. Before the end of October, you will be notified if your proposal has been accepted or declined.

Call for Contributions

How to submit a proposal

You can submit your proposal online from 1 June 2007 to 30 September 2007. Note that the deadline for submission of proposals in the 1st round is **31 July 2007**; for the 2nd round it is **30 September 2007**. The majority of the Forum events will be selected in the 1st round.

For your preparations, we ask you to follow the following steps:

1. Choose the language of your preference (English, French or Spanish)
2. Select the [thematic stream](#) to which your event contributes
3. Select the [event type](#) for your proposal
4. Define what your event would contribute to the Barcelona Legacy
5. Provide:
 - Working title of the event
 - Brief description of the event
 - The outcomes your event would achieve
 - Your contact information
6. Indicate the [support](#) you would need to develop a detailed proposal if your concept is accepted. (note that there will be a charge for support provided)

NOTE: All events will be scheduled for 90 minutes with 30 minutes between events. [Selection criteria](#) will be used to review and select all events.




