


OFMP 2 OBJECTIVE

To support Pacific SIDS to implement & enforce arrangements for the conservation & management of transboundary oceanic fisheries



Western Pacific Ocean in Context


Pacific EEZs versus Ocean Basins


Tuna catch by Ocean Basin (2014)







- FFA skype group operational and active at all times during all WCPFC meetings





CONTEXT - INTEGRATING THE PROJECT INTO ESTABLISHED ORGANISATIONAL PROCESSES

For all these meetings, key processes have been established: For example - TCC

- 1. TCC issues considered at MCSWG and conveyed to FFC
- 2. WCPFC TCC papers posted website and reviewed and analyzed by FFA Secretariat
- 3. FFA TCC brief prepared and distributed to members
- 4. FFA members pre TCC meeting to review brief
- 5. Brief summarised in agreed TCC meeting talking points



CONTEXT - INTEGRATING THE PROJECT INTO ESTABLISHED ORGANISATIONAL PROCESSES

- 6. TCC meeting held FFA members present talking points as agreed
- 7. FFA members skype group active throughout the meeting

Key result: FFA members are well informed on TCC issues and united on key positions

These processes apply to all WCPFC meetings



OFMP 2 and Institutional change – new technology FFA - OFMP 2 Component 3

- EM and ER technology and e CDS is fast evolving – data entry at source = more focus in administrations on data analysis and follow up (ie anomalies)
- Potential for change in the way administrations do business – structure – function – organisation
- Significant HR implications training nature of jobs
- Potential change in decision making processes greater organisational efficiency












CATCH VALUE AND ACCESS FEES
