GEF Principles for Involvement

- ♣ Enhance projects' social, environmental, financial sustainability.
- Responsibility of country governments & project executing agencies.
- ◆ Activities designed and implemented for **flexibility**, adapting and responding to national and local conditions and to project requirements
- → Transparency and openness in deliberation and implementation
- ◆ **Documentation** of public involvement activities...





GEF Policy on Public Involvement

- All GEF-financed projects will provide for:
 - [1] full <u>disclosure and dissemination</u> of nonconfidential <u>information</u>, and
 - [2] <u>consultation</u> with, and [3] <u>participation</u> (as appropriate) of, major groups and local communities throughout the project cycle.
- → BUT little GEF guidance on *how* to do so...


