### Climate Change Conference: Making the connections

The Cornell Center for a Sustainable Future and the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences are organizing a half-day mini-conference on climate change for **Tuesday, May 6th from 8:30-noon in Call Auditorium, Kennedy Hall** for faculty and staff.
