# METOLONG DAM PROJECT

- The Metolong dam project forms part of the Lesotho Lowlands Water Supply Project
- LLWSP is aimed at providing domestic and industrial water supply for Maseru and some towns nearby
- Metolong dam and related reservoirs form raw water storage component of the project
