# CfE News Update -- Anthony Hay takes reins from Mark Bain as CfE Director

Anthony G. Hay, Associate Professor in the Department of Microbiology, has been named Interim Director of the Cornell Center of the Environment (CfE), effective July 1, 2007. Hay succeeds Mark B.
