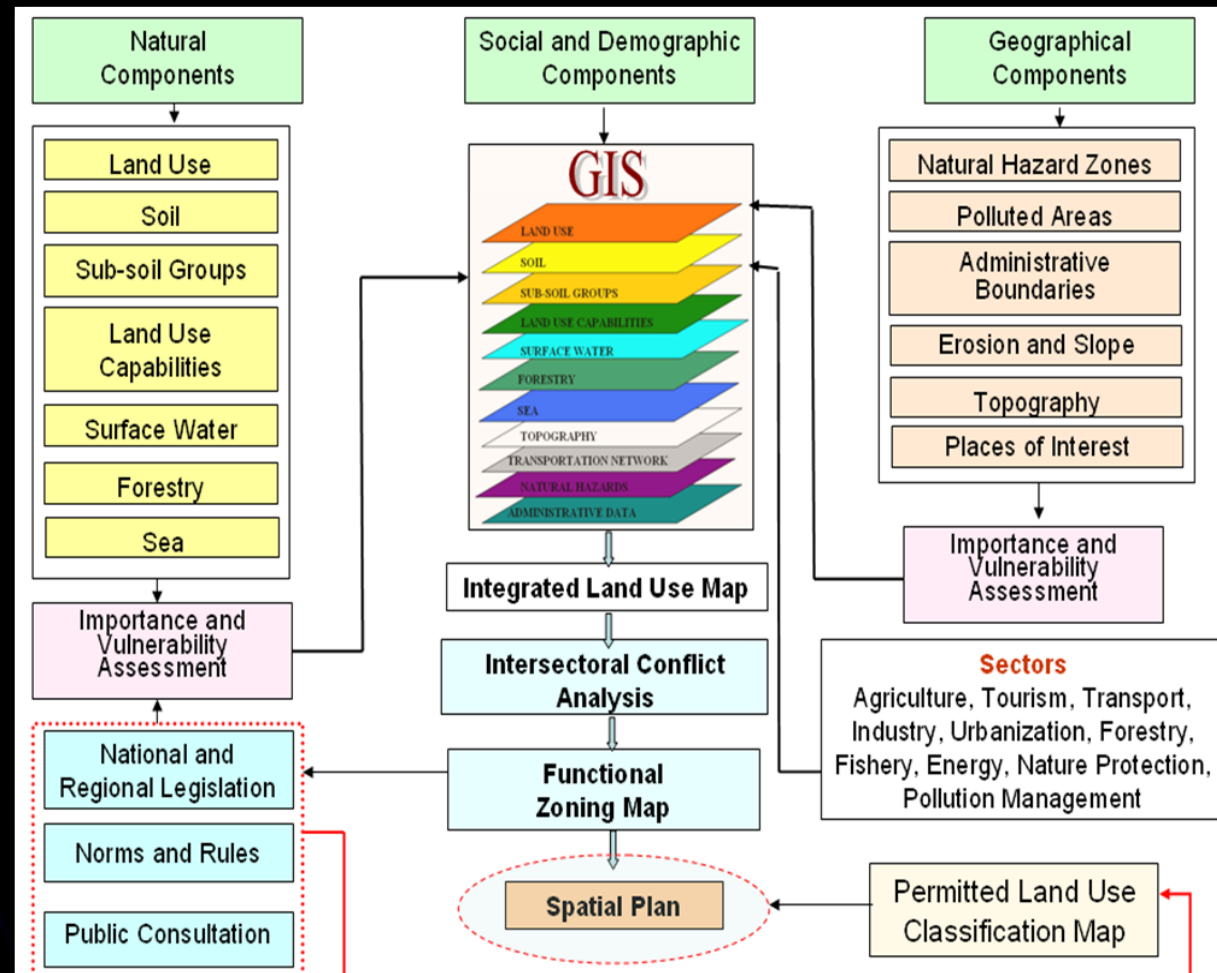

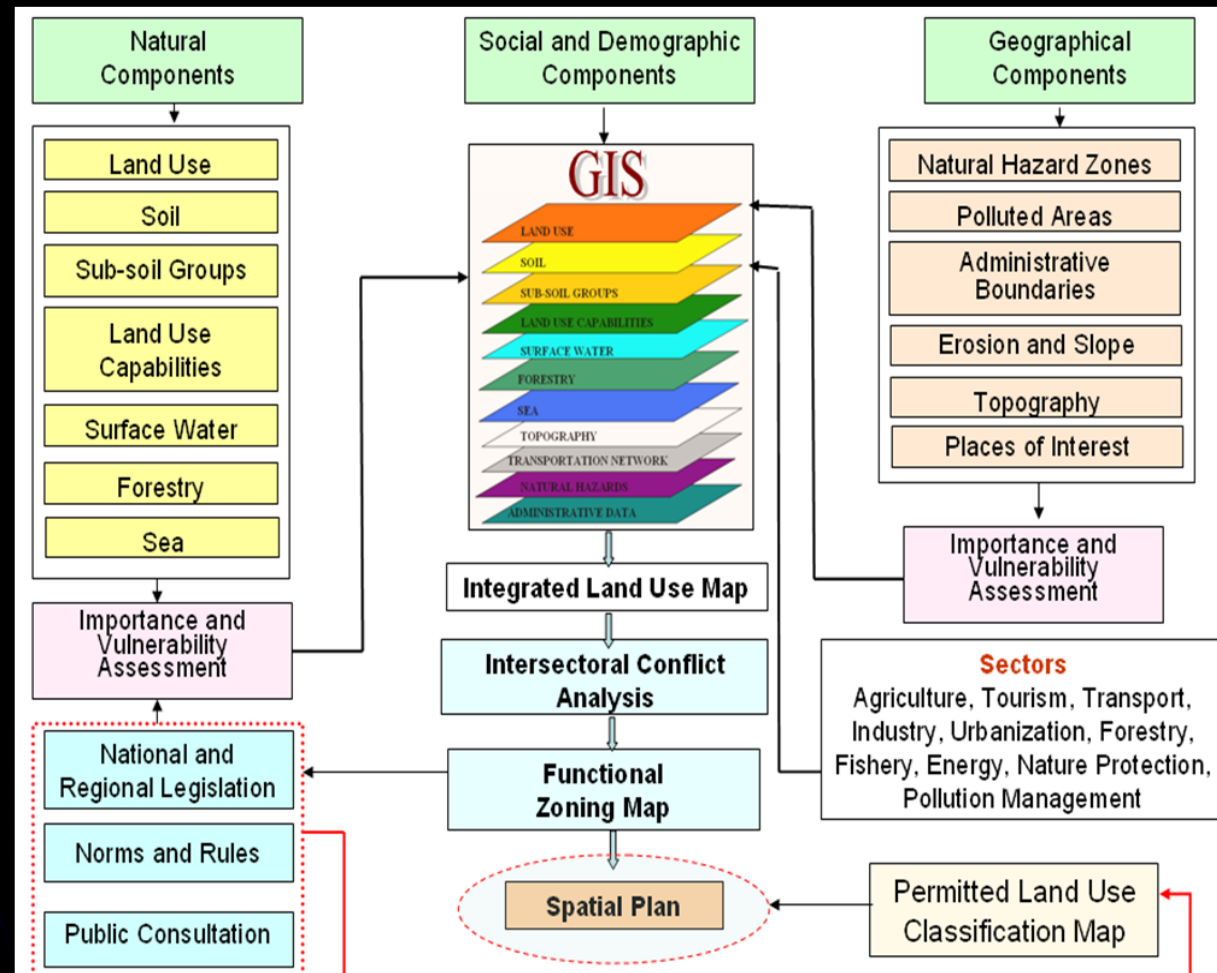

- A draft management plan for the Tiligulskiy Liman Ramsar site has been developed and published

Pilot Monitoring Exercises

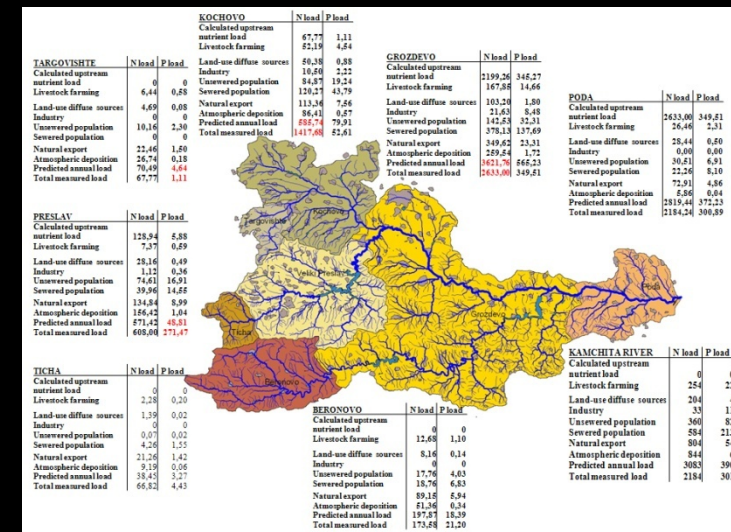
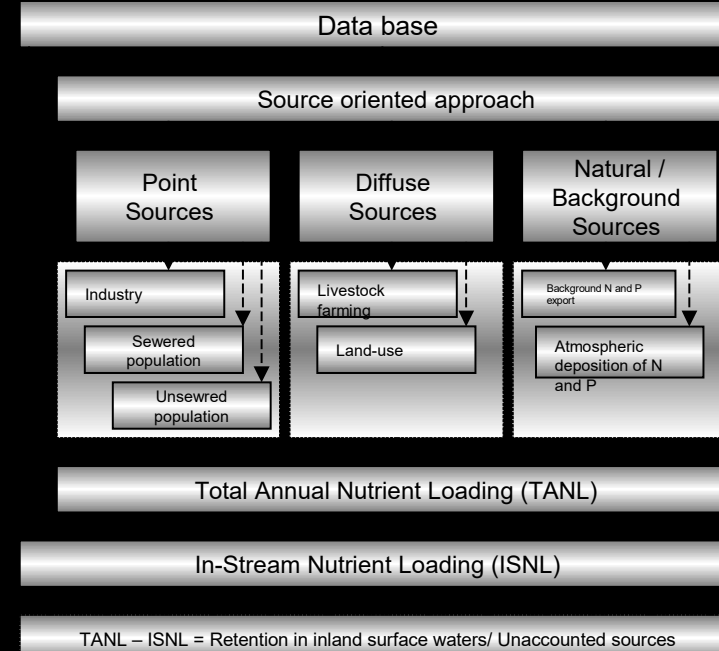
Two Pilot Monitoring Exercises

1. Identification of the specific biological, chemical and physical indicators for the Black Sea (countries)
 2. Investigation of the regional capacity to undertake monitoring of the selected indicators
 3. Recommendation for training and equipment needs in each country
 4. Initiation of training for specific indicators and QA/QC

Kamchyia River Basin Management

Pilot Project

- Nutrient export from within the Kamchiya River Basin to the Black Sea
- Nutrient source apportionment modelling approach
- Approach reflects recent experiences in other European river basins
- Similar approaches could be used in other basins



VTOPIIS

- ✱ Assessment of the current situation on management of ship-related information in Bulgaria
- ✱ Design a VTOPIIS system for collection, update, exchange and management of information, including generation of required reports
- ✱ A proposal for multiplication of VTOPIIS in the other Black Sea countries
- ✱ A separate poster is available in the exhibition area



Mykolaiv Water & Sewerage Project

- Technical Feasibility Studies completed
- Public Consultations Completed
- Project Approval by City Parliament confirmed
- State Guarantee Procedure started
- National Grant contribution confirmed
- EC Grant confirmed and grant agreement signed with EC/EIB
- Construction Works underway (€2.3M)
- A separate presentation
- A poster is available in the exhibition area

Crimea Regional Water & Sewerage Project

- Key issues identified
- Recommendations made how to address the issues
