

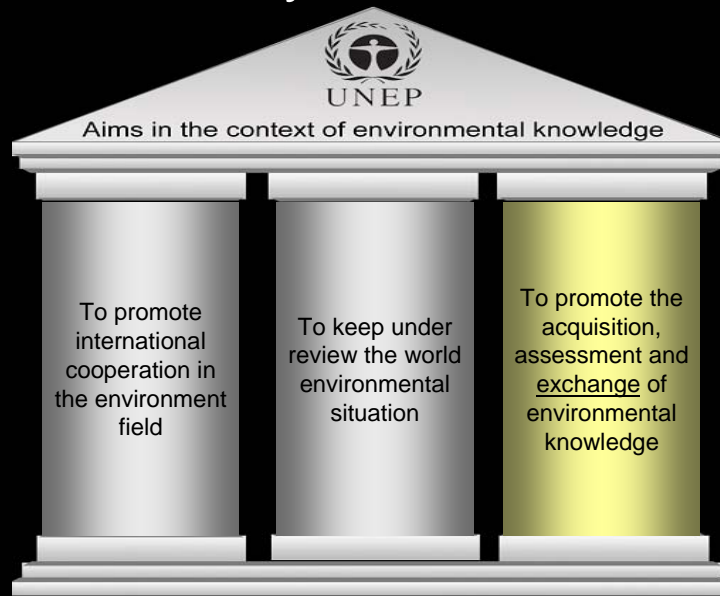

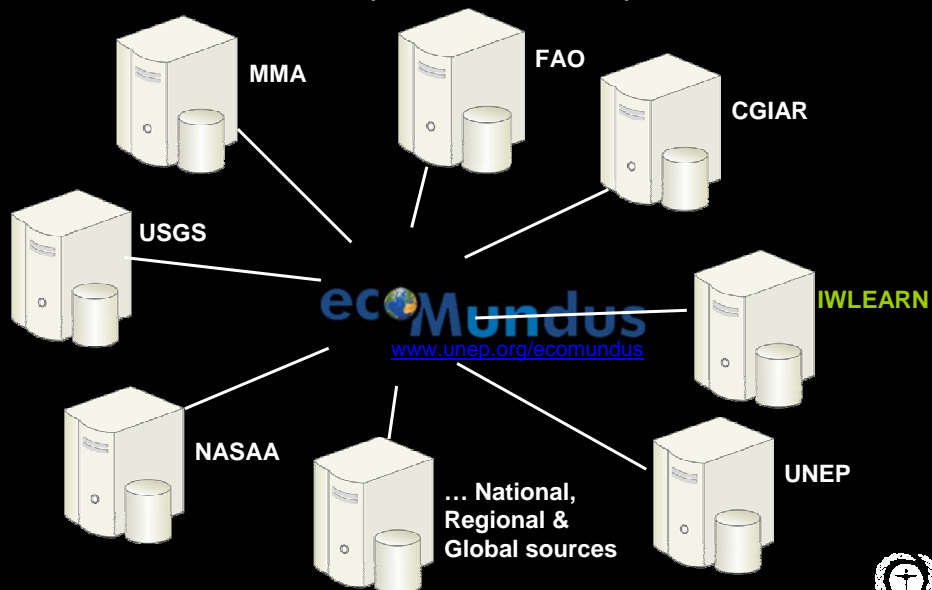

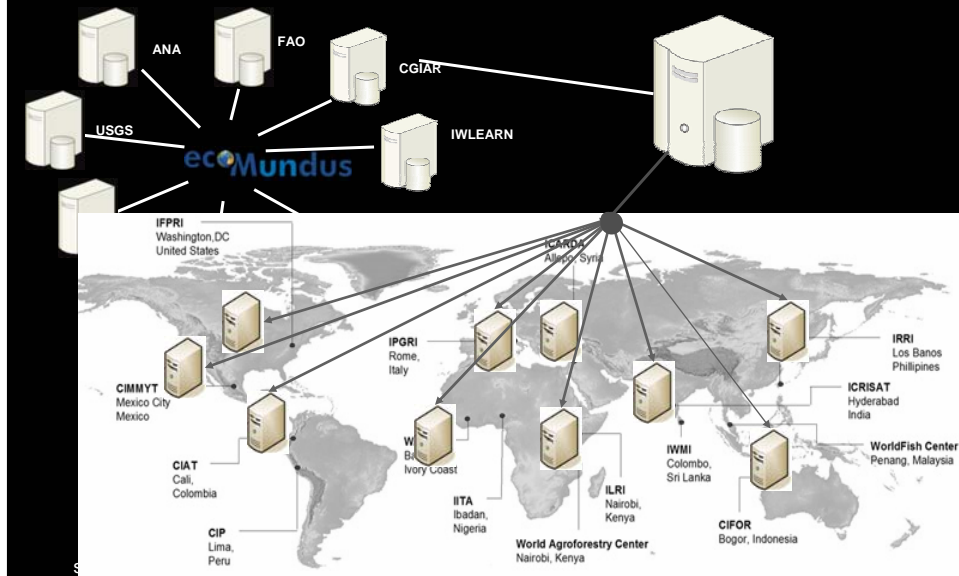
ecomundus (distributed) Network



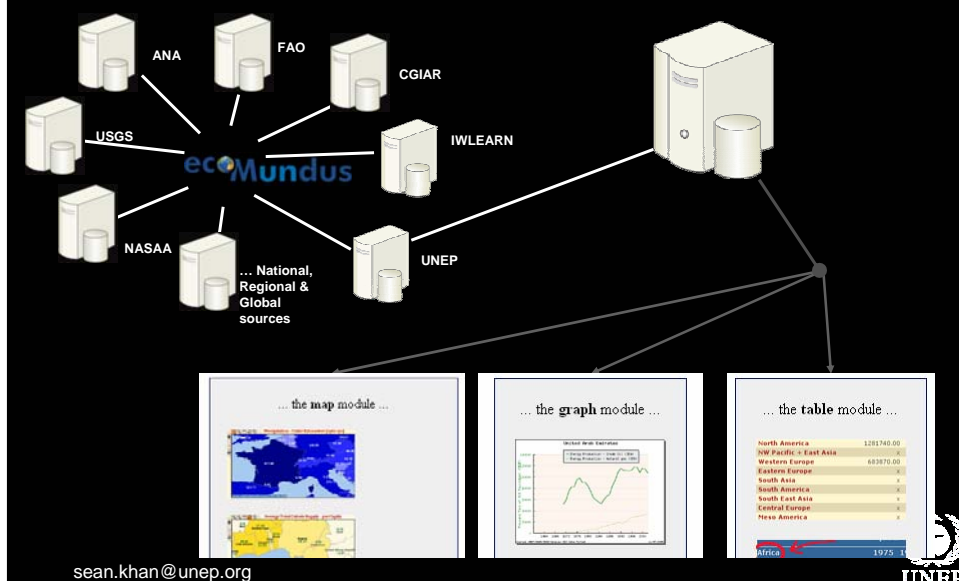

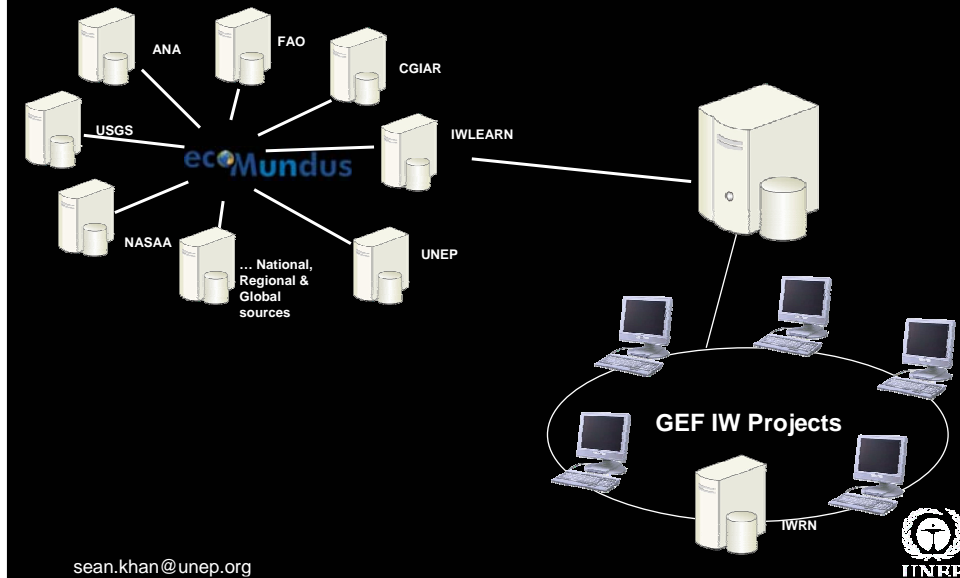

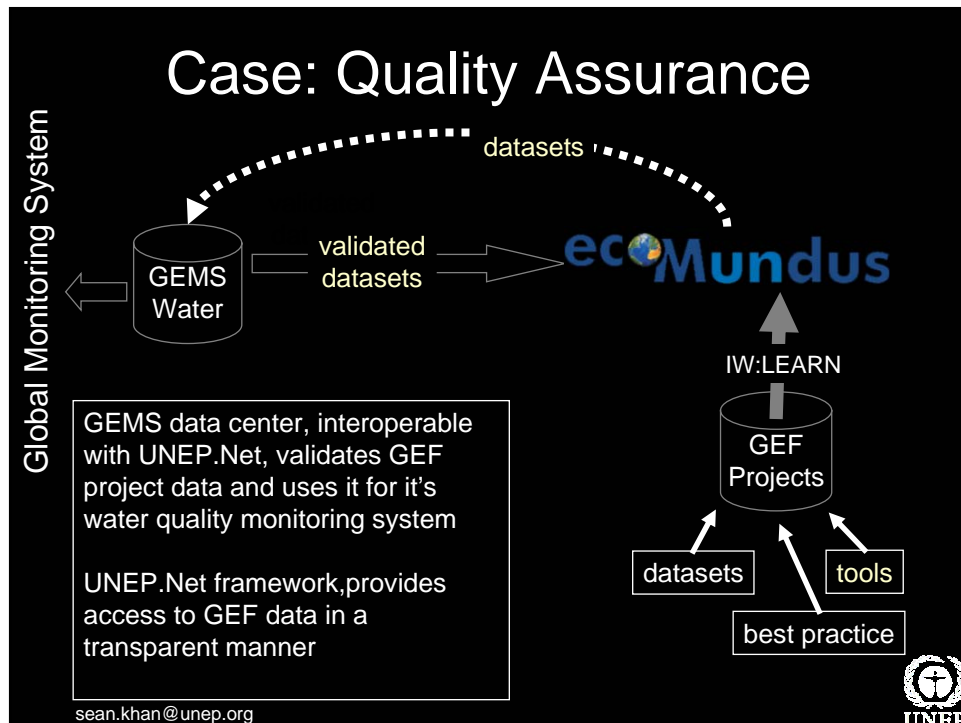
